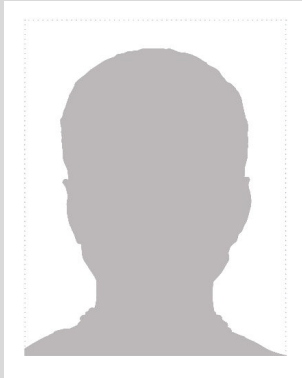

- I understand that use or possession of a forged or false Kiribati travel document is a very serious offence, punishable by imprisonment for up to 10 years, a fine of up to \$20,000, or both.
- I understand that a Kiribati passport remains the property of the Republic at all times.
- I authorise the Secretary for Foreign Affairs and Immigration to make any enquiries the Secretary considers necessary concerning this passport application.
